## Principal's Message

### State Budget Crisis

The budget crisis at the state level continues. This will have implications at the district and site levels. We are not sure of the eventual impact, but an estimate of our district's "fair share" of pending reductions will be roughly \$2 million out of the district's 2010-11 budget. The district is looking at revenue sources such as installation of solar collectors at schools to save

on our energy bill, but further cuts in services are a strong possibility. Please check out the district web site for updates as this process continues through the spring.

### High School Exit Exam

The exit exam (CAHSEE) will be administered to all tenth graders on February 2 and 3. Passing this test is required for a high

school diploma. The results are also used to determine if our district will remain in federal Program Improvement (PI) status. Parental support contributes to student success. Please encourage your student to get adequate rest the nights before this exam and to try his/her best on the test.

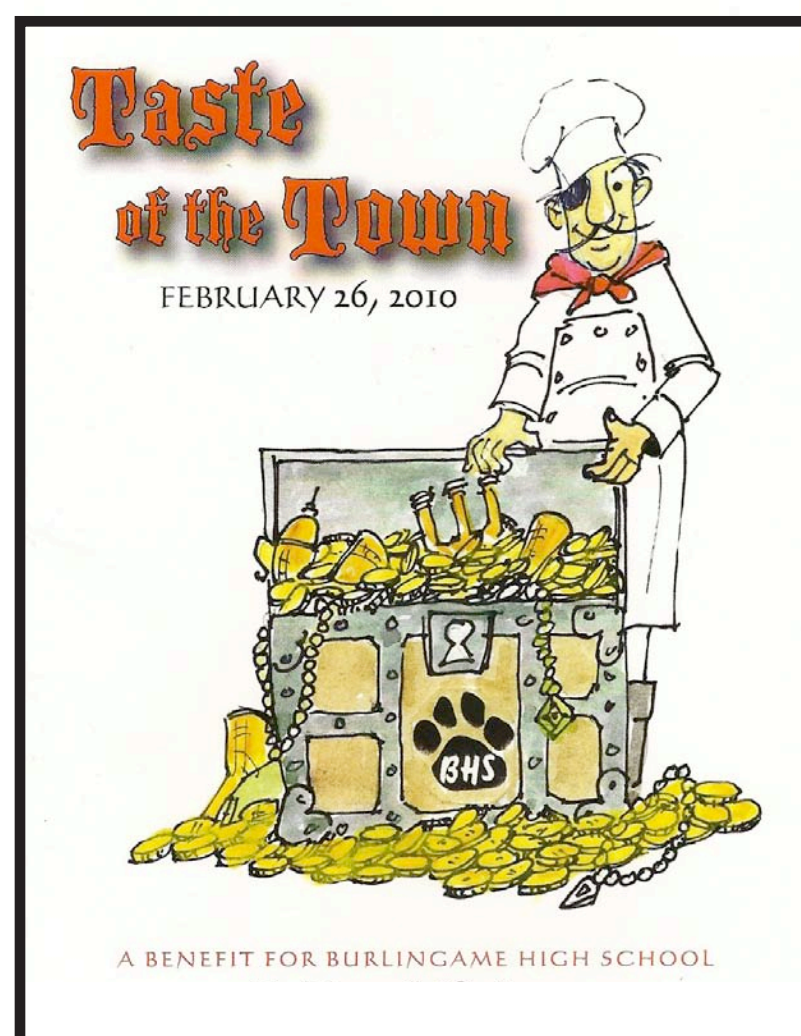

(Exploring Pathways Learning Opportunities Real Experiences)

## Job Shadow Spring Signups

Prior to winter break, over 100 students registered for the spring job shadow opportunity in March. Job Shadow week will occur between March 15-26. This will be the final job shadow of the 2009-2010 school year!

## Speakers

Bruce Bartlett from the Silicon Valley Conference for Community and Justice spoke to Jim Burke and Morgan Hallabrin's senior English classes on the issues surrounding the holocaust and genocide.

Nicolas Shakoour, a former BHS grad (1998), spoke to Diane McClain's speech class on his journey from high school to where he is now in terms of his career. Nicolas was one of the original EXPLORE students who used the program and job shadowing which helped him determine his future. He began in the video production class at BHS and was originally interested in making music videos. His journey led him from music videos to going to Hollywood and doing voiceovers to now making his first movie where he will be in the leading role.

Patty Sperry, radiological technician from Mills/Peninsula, spoke to Speech class about the importance of choosing a healthy lifestyle and the dangers of drugs and tobacco.

Helen Farkas, a 90 year old Holocaust survivor, will speak in the auditorium on Feb. 24 during 3rd and 4th periods to the sophomore social science classes about her experiences in the death camps and the treatment she endured during WWII.

Mike Pahre from the FBI will be speaking to the speech class on careers in law enforcement.

Magic Jeanne will be speaking to the speech class about meeting life's challenges and her journey through many obstacles that she faced growing up.

Steve Sidore, an executive from T-Mobile net, will be speaking to the speech classes about the importance of technology and the history of mobile communications.

Craig Hall from Western Career College will speak to the speech classes about the option of considering a vocational college education.

## Online Interest Inventories

During the month of January, the EXPLORE program, Lori Friel, and the counseling department met with all ninth and tenth grade English classes in the IMAC lab. The students took an online interest inventory to explore their interests and matching careers. The job-shadowing program was introduced to all the students.
